The meeting was called to order at 5:15 p.m. by Superintendent Robin Spears, in the Sheldon High School Library, Sheldon, Iowa.

Individuals present: Gary Ihnen, Kathy Brock, Robin Spears, Bill Borchers, Jim Gude, Tammie Boone, Gary D'Agrosa, Chuck Missman, and Bekah Porter.

Superintendent Spears presented the initial proposal from the Sheldon Community School District (SCSD) and explained it. The proposal represents an increase of 1.23% over the 2006-2007 salaries and benefit package, and agrees to the language changes as presented in the Sheldon Education Association's (SEA) Opening Proposal regarding Article XVI (E) in the Master Contract language.

Superintendent Spears said that there have been some questions in the Career Merit levels and advancement.

Superintendent Spears said that he has been in contact with Wellmark through Ron Rensink, and also has had preliminary talks with Farm Bureau Agent, Randy Clark. It is hoped to have the next year's health insurance premium by the first part of February 2007.

Superintendent Spears and the SEA will work on setting up the next meeting. It is tentatively set for Wednesday, January 17, 2007 at 5:30 p.m. The meeting will be a closed meeting, and will be held in the Board Room.
